That said, we would like to make one more effort to engage in conversations over how we might reach a win-win conclusion. There are numerous other potential options, such as a joint-use agreement, or forming a JPA for the development and operations of an art center.

We've received emails from over 500 people over the last few weeks, and have listened to hours of public testimony. As you've witnessed as well, many people, in very heartfelt terms, are pleading with us to find a solution to keep this site in public use.
